

## **City of Fort Calhoun Enhancement Committee**

The Meeting was held Monday April 5, 2010 at the Longhorn Bar, 101 South 14<sup>th</sup> Street at 6:00 p.m.

Meeting was called to order by Judy Boyd, Chairman.

The open meeting compliance was noted with regulations available for review.

On roll call, the following members were present: Dixie Humphrey, Judy Seaver, Lana Schafer and La Donna Schuler. Absent: Sue Newman and Kathy Ohrt.

Minutes of the March 1, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

Judy Seaver will order flowers for planters on Main Street at wholesale from the Washington County Growers Association. Planters and Soil will be obtained from retail; planters from last year will also be utilized. Motion by Dixie to budget \$300.00 for this project, motion approved.

Judy Seaver will be meeting with David Genoways to discuss plantings and curb improvement at the Fort Calhoun Trailhead; she will also contact Rock Hard Concrete for bids. Motion by Lana Shafer, motion approved.

Dixie will head the Adopt-a-Street Spring Promotion. Motion by LaDona to budget \$25.00 for message on the Electronic sign and \$10.00 for water for kickoff, motion approved.

Application forms are being completed to OPPD for using poles for Adopt-a-Street plaques.

West Market Square Display case is being repaired by city maintenance. Motion by Lana to budget \$50.00 for displays in 2010, motion carried.

Historical marker - Sue Newman is working on the text to be submitted to the Nebraska State Historical Society for a new marker by the Jaycee Field, site of the old Fort Calhoun High School. Motion by Judy to budget \$2,000.00 for the project, motion carried. Sue will present the project to the City Council and the School District when appropriate.

Banners – La Donna Schuler is still working with some school classes for banner designs for the blank canvases. Suggestions for patriotic banners for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and for POW/MIA and branches of the service were made. Dixie motioned to budget \$150.00 for this project, motion carried.

Motion by Lana to budget \$150.00 for spring and summer decorations for city hall, motion carried.

Enhancement members will maintain the planters on main street; but the are concerned who will be caring for the plantings at the Fort Calhoun Trailhead.

The next meeting will be held on Monday, May 3, 2010 at Goldie's Deli, 710 North 14<sup>th</sup> Street.
