Fort Calhoun Trailhead improvement – Judy Seaver will complete plans for a proposal after consultation with David Genoways about the possibility of a fence, plantings and a curb combination. No action taken.

Adopt-a-Street Project – The application has been sent to O.P.P.D. for sign posting on poles, pending.

Display Board at West Market Square Park – Lana Schafer and Kathy Ohrt are facilitating monthly changes of displays.

The proposed Historical Marker Project design and measurements have been given to FCCS Superintendent, Don Johnson. The final draft of the text is in process. Plans will be presented to the FCCS Facilities and grounds committee and then the project will be presented to the City Council for approval, expenditures, maintenance and placement.

Banners – Proposed schedule for displays: January and February – Snow Flakes; March and April – Birds; May and June – Historical; July and August – Patriotic; September and October – School Designs; November – Service and POW; November and December – Christmas. Members are proposing the purchase of new Christmas banners.
