Subject: Enhancement November Minutes

The Fort Calhoun Enhancement Committee meeting was held Monday, November 7th at 6:00 p.m. at the Rustic Inn, South 14th Street.

The meeting was open to the Public with the open meetings policy available for review.

Meeting was called to order by Judy Boyd, Chair. Present on roll call - LaDona Schuler, Dixie Humphrey, Kathy Ohrt, Judy Seaver, Lana Schafer and Sue Newman. Absent - Sherri Brooks; visitor – Rose Therkildsen.

Minutes of the October 3, 2011 meeting were read and approved.

Historical Marker: The October 16, 2011 Dedication went well; a thank you note was sent to WCHS for the coffee at the Frahm House. Ideas were discussed to apply for the BACF grant next year to install a stone with picture of the Old High School. Sue Newman will meet with the Pioneer Foundation about placing a brick/stone walkway.

Committee Member Terms: Judy Boyd and Lana Schafer are interested in being re-appointed for three (3) years; Kathy Ohrt does not wish to serve again.

New Members: Recommendation again for Rose Therkildsen to serve the 2012 – 2014 term.

Community Wide Art Project: Kathy Ohrt motioned to begin on planning a community wide art project; involving life size depictions on plywood of historical and community life to be placed on public property. The art and woodworking classes at FCHS have agreed to do some of this project in the 2012-13 school-year. Other possibilities for the art work project will be explored at a later time.
