Trailhead Improvement Status - Judy Seaver will have final plans ready for approval soon.

Adopt -A-Street Project Report - received word about placement of recognition signs on street light poles. OPPD has given tentative approval with some stipulations before final approval . Judy Boyd will be consulting with city clerk about final designs and we will be sending a report to OPPD. Wording for signs is tentatively: Litter Control by Boy Scout Troop 114, or Spanish Club, ect.

Banner Report - Committee members are still looking for new holiday or winter banners for display.

Historical Marker Project Report – marker text has been sent into the state historical board for review and FCHS superintendent has been given a copy. Status - pending.

City Hall Holiday Decorations will be placed on the Sunday after thansgiving at 1:00 p.m. The committee will be purchasing a few new strings of lights as neededto insure functioning. Voted to place wreaths on welcome to Fort Calhoun signs as you come into town at both ends, will consult with city clerk if can add anything to decorative poles to enhance display.

Another “Holiday Lighting Contest” was approved for business and homes categories which are within the city limits. Judging will be December 13<sup>th</sup>. Prizes first place - \$75. 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$50 , 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$25. Any committee member wishing to judge may do so.

Happy City Article was presented by Ladona Schuler for review.

Street Planters Maintenance will be trying to cleanup and arrange storage of the planters on November 15<sup>th</sup> if weather permits.

Main Street Improvement Ideas - Scare crow contest next fall presented by Lana and an idea for patriotic displays on mainstreet for summer.

“Walk Fort Calhoun” – discussion was tabled until 2011.
