- WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has reviewed the FY 2013 through 2018 Capital Improvement Program as submitted by the Mayor and recommends adoption by the City Council; and
- WHEREAS, after study and consideration, it is the belief of this City Council that approval of the Capital Improvement Program for FY 2013 through 2018 is in the best interest of the City of Fort Calhoun, Nebraska.

Administrative Summary

Visions and Goals

Goals, policies and programs established in the Fort Calhoun Comprehensive Plan serve as the basis for this capital improvement program, and will be used to implement the comprehensive plan. The following goals, objectives, policies, and processes, relevant to capital improvements were established during that planning process:

Community Goal #5 Additional recreational opportunities.

Community Goal #6 Improvements to City services and City service facilities.

Objectives:

- 1. To promote sound financial planning
- 2. To avoid dramatic fluctuations of the tax rate
- 3. To serve as a guide for local officials in making budgetary decisions
- 4. To provide for improvements in a timely and systematic manner

Process

In 2006, the City of Fort Calhoun completed the Fort Calhoun Comprehensive Plan and, subsequently, updates to the zoning and subdivision regulations. In addition to the use of zoning and subdivision regulations to implement a municipality's comprehensive plan, there are several other tools that can be used effectively to achieve goals and objectives of the plan. A capital improvement program (CIP) is a planning tool that provides a process to identify, prioritize, schedule and budget for large-scale public expenditures that are expected to have a relatively long life. The process of preparing a capital improvement program is a logical adjunct to the comprehensive planning process. A capital improvement usually involves an investment in land, buildings, or other public works, which produce public services or benefits. Capital improvements may also include expenditures for large, long-lasting, pieces of equipment, and studies, or surveys by consultants.

The capital improvement program sets priorities for new facilities or improvements and it examines the financing options needed to pay for long-term improvements. Goals, policies, and programs established in the comprehensive plan should serve as the basis of the capital improvement program, and the program, in turn, becomes one of the devices (along with the zoning chapter and the subdivision chapter, amended and revised February 18, 2013) used to implement the comprehensive plan.

The capital improvement program is to include all needed improvements and expenditures, which should be constructed, repaired, installed, or purchased during a given period of time, usually five to six years. The plan should be reviewed annually, at which time priorities will be reassessed, completed projects removed, new projects added, and the program extended one additional year. Each year's program, when adopted becomes the capital improvement budget for the next fiscal year. The budget "funds" the development of projects for the coming year. By the process of annual review, the program is continuing process in which an up-to-date schedule of projects can be monitored.
